

1. Sauvignon Blanc Terres d'Azur 2015/16 £19.95

A crisp, lively Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of green apple, pink grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is dry and refreshing, with a rounded mid-palate and an elegant finish.

2. Sauvignon Blanc Buitenverwachting 2016 £27.95 South Africa

A pale lemon-coloured wine with a bouqet reminiscent of green figs with hints of gooseberries and green peppers. Dry and full-bodied with a long, lingering finish. 90 points Wine Spectator

3. Castel Firmian Sauvignon Blanc 2015 £25.00 Mezzacorona, Italy

A fresh, invigorating nose of cut grass, elderflower and currant leaf leads to a dry, citrussy, but still quite rounded palate. This roundness alongside a delicately mineral finish is typical Trentino - this is an excellent marriage of grape variety and location.

4. Gran Hacienda Sauvignon Blanc 2016 £23.00 Santa Rita, Chile

Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit character, plus some herbal notes from a drop of Semillon in the blend. Vibrant and well-rounded.

5. Allegory Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon 2014 Australia

An enticing aroma of guava, gooseberry, fig and melon leads to a tropical palate lifted by herbs and citrus. There is great freshness and balance all the way through to the crisp finish.

6. Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek 2016 (1911) £32.00 New Zealand

This is absolutely classic Marlborough Sauvignon: vibrant gooseberry, passion fruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness. Impressive weight of flavour on the palate with richness and texture and a long finish.

7. Menetou-Salon La Charnivolle 2015 £36.00

Aromas of tropical fruits and herbs lead to a dry palate with pear and citrus flavours plus a hint of gooseberry. Crisp and fresh with a zesty finish. Great alternative to Sancerre.

8. Quercus Pinot Grigio 2016 Slovenia £22.95 Concentrated with aromas of pear, grapefruit and pineapple.

Poised, medium-bodied palate with a silky, refreshing finish. £20.50 9. Vinho Verde Anjos de Portugal,

A fine modern Vinho Verde, with aromas of apple and grapefruit alongside herbal notes. The palate is mediumbodied and refreshing, with the classic touch of spritz.


10. Mount Holdsworth Pinot Gris 2014/15 £28.00 Wairappa, New Zealand

A rich, off-dry Pinot Gris in the Alsace mould, showing classic spiced-pear aromas and a wonderful opulent texture on the palate, balanced by a mineral note for freshness.

11. Mon Roc Ugni Blanc/Colombard 2016 £17.90 France

Aromas of white fruits (peach, citrus, grapefruit) and a hint of peony lead to a crisp, fruity palate that is both easydrinking and refreshing.

Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, and a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood. 4 Star

Controlled yet expressive, this wine offers the characteristic exotic aromas of Gewürztraminer - rose petals, lychee and gingerbread – in an elegant, medium-bodied style. This is a Gewurz made for food!

20. Albariño Casal Caeiro 2015 Spain

From the coolest part of Rias Baíxas, this wine bursts with juicy Albariño character: pear, citrus fruit, musky perfume and hints of mineral and spice. Clean, intense and very long on the palate.







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DRAPPIER

CAVES à REIMS - FRANCE

Champagne Drappier was founded in Urville by François Drappier in 1808 and has remained family owned to this day. At their home in the heart of the Aube, away from the bright lights of Reims and Epernay, the Drappier family, now headed by Michel, produce wines of real character.

The Vineyard

The family own a total of 56ha of vineyards with a further 40ha under contract with growers, both in the Aube and the Marne. Drappier's vineyard, are well exposed and on powerfully calcareous soil, which represents the essential terroir to deliver typical character, typicity and complexity in each cuvees.

The production methods are simple, not to say elementary, so that nature can express itself freely in the wines. The Drappier family's approach to their work, allows innovation to go hand in hand with a respect for the age-old traditions of the region.

The Cellars

Champagne Drappier still occupies the atmospheric 12th century cellars, once belonging to the Cistercian abbey at Clairvaux.

It is through their work in the winery that Champagne Drappier stands out. The winery has over 150 tanks of varying sizes, to enable each parcel and pressing of the grapes from each vineyard to be vinified separately.

All of the wines are unfiltered and the minimum amount of sulphur is used – at fewer than 40 mg/l this is around half of the average for the appellation.

A Pinot Noir-based champagne of style and finesse, Carte d'Or offers delicate aromas of white peach, quince and a touch of spice. The dry, elegant palate shows an impressive degree of concentration, along with fine bubbles and a long, crisp finish.
