When the Apple Dropped £11

Experience a gravitational pull towards the Burleigh Arms with this blend of Apple Vodka enriched with Calvados and TeKairanga Riesling, all gently elongated with Fevertree Soda.

DNA £11

Inspired by Charles Wells' maritime adventures and his ashore indulgence in Genesis Stout, this cocktail is a tribute to life's intricate mysteries. Blended with Vodka, a robust Town & Gown espresso, a whisper of Genesis Stout reduction, and a splash of Kahlua, it's our secret to savouring the everyday.

Puntstar £11.50

A celestial twist on the infamous Pornstar Martini, originally crafted by mixology maestro Doug Ankrah. This stellar concoction features Vodka infused with vanilla, passionfruit liqueur, and pineapple juice, crowned with a scoop of prosecco-infused mini ice cream. A drink that's truly out of this world.

Shelford £11.75

Steeped in local rugby lore, this cocktail is named after a legendary figure from the Cambridge Rugby Club known as 'Shelford Man'. Whether on the field or in a glass, this robust mix of Janneau VSOP, Angostura Bitters, and a slice of orange, all kissed with a smoke aroma, captures the spirit and strength of its namesake.

Bear(e) in my Room: £11

In a defiant nod to Lord Byron's audacious spirit, this wildly inventive tiki beer cocktail celebrates the poet's choice to house a bear at Trinity College. A fusion of Gold Rum, mango & pineapple puree, with exotic dragon fruit and papaya syrup, topped with a splash of Pacific pale ale.

The Dark Side of the Moon £10.50

A psychedelic tribute to the iconic Pink Floyd, this cocktail promises a sensory journey. Swirls of tequila, cherry & vanilla syrup, pineapple juice, and a hint of Jägermeister craft a cocktail as mesmerizing as the band's timeless music.

A Night on Your Backs £11.50

Inspired by the picturesque Backs along the River Cam, this cocktail is as refreshing as a leisurely punt down the river. Gin, sweet strawberry shrub, exotic tropical juice, and a touch of fizz create a drink that's as memorable as the views.

Reality Checkpoint £11

Named after the historic lamppost on Parker's Piece, this cocktail marks the crossing from the academic bubble into the vibrant town life. Orange wine, sweet vermouth and a splash of London dry gin blended together to hit reality.
