

9. Cuvee Jean Paul Rouge, France

Deep ruby red in colour, this wine has intense aromas of chocolate, black and red fruits with spicy notes of black pepper. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied with smooth and rounded tannins and a long finish. Montes Flagship range. \*D

14. Claude Cazals Carte Blanche Champagne NV, France
