Crisp, dry & refreshing white with a lovely little extra pepperiness from the vermentino

Pasquiers Grenache, Cinsault rose, Languedoc, France £4.95/£5.95/£15.95

Dry, pale, classic Provençal style rose with a lovely raspberry and herby spice

Medium sweet with strawberry ice cream aromas

Red

Borsao Garnacha, Compo de Borja, Spain £4.50/£5.50/ £14.95

Medium bodied red, bursting with red berry fruit, great crowd pleasing red, good on its own or with a burger

Terre Forti Sangiovese Rubicone, Emilia-Romagna, Italy £4.95/£5.95/ £16.95

Medium bodied, juicy cherry fruit and vanilla, great with pizza

Emiliana Pinot Noir, Bio-Bio valley, Chile £5.95/ £7.50/ £22

Low tannin, lighter red, but great long flavour with lots of red fruit & gentle spice.

Pablo Y Walter Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina £6.80/£8.50/£24
