Mount Gay 1703 rum includes rums aged between 10 and 30 years that are joined by master distiller Allen Smith. Mount Gay Distilleries is the oldest operating distillery in the Americas - producing rum in Barbados since 1703, hence the rum's name. It's original name was Mount Gilboa, and in 1801 renamed Mount Gay after the distillery's manager Sir John Gay Alleyne.

Know your Whisky

Scotch is a whisky (no e) that gets its distinctive smoky flavor from the process in which it is made: the grain, primarily barley, is malted and then heated over a peat fire. A whisky cannot be called Scotch unless it is entirely produced and bottled in Scotland.

Bourbon, a whiskey that was first produced in Kentucky, U.S., uses at least 51 percent mash from corn in its production. It also uses a sour mash process — that is, the mash is fermented with yeast and includes a portion from a mash that has already been fermented. U.S. regulations specify that in order for a whiskey to be called bourbon, it must be made in the United States.

And rye whiskey? It's a whiskey that uses a rye mash or a rye and malt mash. In the United States, regulations stipulate that the mash must be at least 51 percent rye in order for it to be called rye whiskey. In Canada, regulations do not specify a minimum percentage of rye.

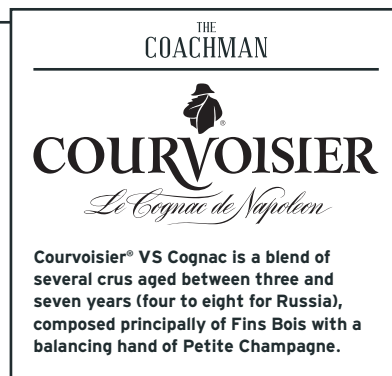

Single Malts

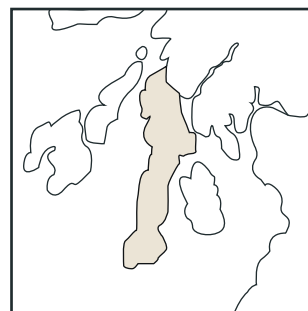

Campbeltown

Campbeltown was once a thriving malt whisky region with no fewer than 34 distilleries – no mean feat for a small and remote settlement at the bottom of the Kintyre peninsula. 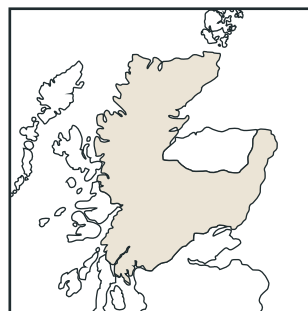

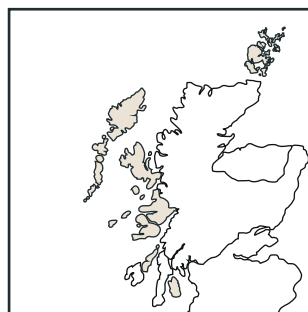

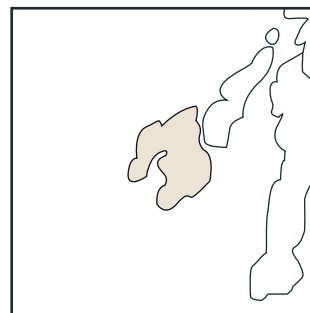
Islay

Long Island Iced Tea

Tale of 2 Origins

When fans of 1920s noir tell the tale, the drink is attributed to one Old Man Bishop, a native of a Kingsport, Tennessee community known as Long Island. During the country's Prohibition era, when a constitutional amendment banned the sale, consumption, and production of alcoholic drinks from 1920 to 1933, resourceful Americans tried their hands at cocktail-crafting. It was during this period when Bishop allegedly combined tequila, vodka, gin, rum, whiskey, and maple syrup and, in a stroke of creativity, called his creation the "Old Man Bishop."

Another origin story holds that the drink wasn't invented until the 1970s, making it the youngest widely known cocktail. In this version, a bartender from Long Island, New York, named Robert Butt created the Long Island Iced Tea during a 1972 cocktail-crafting competition. The story's source? None other than Butt himself. The former Oak Beach Inn bartender claims to have invented the drink as his entry in a contest to create an original cocktail featuring triple sec. Butt asserts that his creation was an instant success, with cocktail lovers around the world enjoying it since the 1980s.
