The Six Classic Malts Of Scotland

Oban 14 Year Old - West Highland Region

Combining the sophistication of the Highlands with a touch of the peaty style of the Islands. It is rich and full-bodied with a mellow fruity finish.

Glenkinchie - Lowlands Region

Glenkinchie, known as 'Edinburgh whisky' is a soft, sweetly aromatic malt from the 'Garden of Scotland'. It has a fresh, grassy sweetness balanced with a warming, dryish finish.

Cragganmore 12 Year Old - Speyside Region

An elegant, sophisticated Speyside with the most complex aroma of any malt. Astonishingly fragrant with sweetish notes and a smoky maltiness on the finish.

Talisker 10 Year Old - Islands Region

The only malt produced on Skye. Its seaweedy, smoky nose and sweet maltiness is perfectly complimented by a spicy, long finish.

Dalwhinnie 15 Year Old - Highland Region

A gentle, delicate malt from the wild and windswept Highlands. It is subtle, smooth delicately smoky malt with a heathery honey finish.

Lagavulin 16 Year Old - Islay Region

A distinctive and powerful Islay malt. It is deeply smoky and peaty with a velvety, complex finish. Brilliant with Stilton!





Our other single malts

Glenfiddich 12 Years Old - Speyside

The World's favourite single malt whisky. Pale and golden in colour. Rich fruit flavours, subtle pine and with a hint of peatiness. Long, lingering and round.

Highland Park 12 Year Old - Orkney Islands

The heart and soul of Highland Park, a perfect harmony of aromatic smoky peat, sweet heather honey and rich fruit cake. Perfect with soft cheeses such as our smoked Brie.

Balvenie Doublewood 12 Years Old - Speyside

A Windmill favourite! Sweet fruit and Oloroso sherry notes, layered with honey and vanilla on the nose. To taste, it's smooth and mellow with beautifully combined flavours ~ nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness and a delicately proportioned layer of sherry. Long and Warming finish. Pair it with the Grande Noir creamy blue cheese.

Glenmorangie Original 10 Years - Highlands

The well-balanced flavour carries traces of honey, wood and nuts, whilst the aftertaste is clean and salving. This is a malt with an overall impression that is refined and fresh. Fabulous with the Black Bomber.

Laphroaig 10 Year Old - Islay

The definitive Islay single malt: peaty, smoky, challenging, rewarding. Made from malted barley which is first cold-smoked and then dried over a peat fire.

The smoke from the unique Islay peat gives Laphroaig its particular rich flavour. This peated whisky is renowned for its bold, smoky taste, followed by a hint of seaweed and a surprising sweetness. Great with strong blue cheeses.

The Singleton 12 Year Old - Speyside

12 year old single malt scotch whisky is matured in a high proportion of American oak casks with a small portion of European oak casks to balance the liquid. The result is an easy to enjoy single malt with fresh fruit aromas, a sweet honeyed palate and a creamy lingering finish. Enjoy with the Dorset Red!

Scottish Blends

The Famous Grouse

Medium-full flavour, mature, Speyside frutiness with an aroma of well balanced oak, sherry and just a hint of citrus.

Monkey Shoulder

A busy, complex and wonderfully weighted nose. Orange-citrus softened by vanilla, excellent malt-oak ratio. Soft mouth arrival and then a steady increase in malt intensity; shard of Demerara sweetness help counter the vanilla; some firm grain early on also guarantees a degree of mouth-watering freshness and bit to balance against the creamy softness. Enormous length with layer upon layer of gently oiled malt slowly diminishing in sweetness.

Haig Club Mediterranean Orange

Haig Club Mediterranean Orange Spirit Drink is made with single grain Scotch whisky and other natural orange flavours. Best enjoyed mixed with Lemonade over ice and a slice of orange for a fresh citrus experience.





From Ireland

The Sexton Single Malt Irish Whiskey

Aged for perfection in former Oloroso sherry casks, the result is a liquid rich in hue with the perfect balance of dried fruits and subtle oak notes and an incredibly smooth finish. The Sexton is crafted using 100% Irish malted barley and triple distilled in copper pot stills resulting in smooth, light and fruit-forward spirit.

Jameson Irish Whiskey

The hallmark smoothness comes down to three factors; triple distillation, controlled maturation and masterly blending of the various whiskey components.

Wild Turkey Kentucky Bourbon Whiskey

Super premium American bourbon from Lawrenceburg Kentucky. One of the biggest names in bourbon, with high rye content for extra spiciness.

Jack Daniels Old No 7 Whiskey

Courvoisier VS

Janneau VSOP
