This is an innocent looking beer that really packs a punch. It is a hazy orange yellow colour, but don't be fooled into thinking it is just another tripel. This beer will attack your senses with a dry bitterness and an aggressive, almost juniper like after taste. Extremely refreshing.

Coloquially known as the queen of Trappist ales, Orval defies comparison to any other Belgian beer. It is delicate yet powerful; dry and incredibly complex – almost akin to a lambic in character. It is clean and crisp, spicy and bitter, and very refreshing. A truly unique beer.

This is a surprisingly light drinking and spritzy beer: mid brown in colour, and perfectly balanced. Gentle aromas of garden herbs, spices and red fruits combine beautifully with the taste of coriander and bitter chocolate.

This is by far the most popular beer of the Rochefort range: it is hazelnut in colour, with sweet fruity aromas and a complex fusion of tastes that start slightly sweet, but leave a wonderful bitter after taste.

This is a big, dark and heavy sipping beer with a port like sweetness, which is mitigated by hints of peppery horseradish, coriander and bitter chocolate. The slight alcohol burn in the after taste serves as a reminder of the potency of this great beer.

This is a wonderful, deep, rich ale, with beautiful red wine aromas and a complex mix of flavours that fully come to life when you add a little of the sediment from the bottle.

This is the beer that is often cited as the original of the modern golden tripels. The sweetish aromas belie the initial sharp bitterness, which gently mellows with some sweeter fruit and vanilla tastes and spicy hop flavours coming to the fore. Full bodied and refreshing.

The classic blond beer from this friendly bunch of cheeky little gnomes. Beautifully subtle, with gentle spicy and grassy hop flavours, blending wonderfully with the touch of coriander that is added to the brew.

The saison style is the classic Wallonian farmhouse beer, which was brewed during the cold winter months for the labourers to drink in the summer when it was too hot for brewing. Dupont Saison is a crisp, dry and bitter thirst quencher, with ample hops.

The name of this beer translates as 'devil', and it certainly puts temptation in your path. This is the classic strong golden ale, with plenty of dry, spicy hops and a full bodied malt sweetness. Just fantastic!

The Head Brewer at Duvel Moorgat has selected the Citra hop to give a wonderful twist to this classic beer. The extra hop enriches the original taste, with additional fresh and subtle flavours of tropical fruits and lemongrass, balanced with a delightful grassy and grapefruity bitterness.

For its strength, this is a deceptively easy drinking clean and crisp golden ale. This starts with dry, grassy, hoppy flavours; followed by a subtly fruity finish.

This beer has a beautifully intriguing hazy golden colour, and a rich complexity of flavours. Sweet fruits dominate, with noticeable herbs, spices and unmalted grains in the background. A delightfully unusual triple.

This is the most popular of the Pilsner style beers within Belgium. It is very light, crisp and smooth. Jupiler puts the commercial lagers available in the UK to shame.

A truly outstanding tripel, this complex golden beer is brewed using wheat, oats and barley; combining the lightness and sweetness of a wheat beer with a smooth oaty creaminess. Floral and citrus aromas predominate, and the taste is refreshing and zesty, with hints of vanilla.

This is a wonderful twist on the classic Brugge beer. Wild yeasts are used in the brewing process, giving a sour fruity flavour, which harmonises beautifully with the floral hop aromas.

## Red

Duchesse de Bourgogne                      33cl                      6.0%                      £6.80

A great example of the very special Flemish Red style. This sweet-sour beer is the result of blending young (8 months) with old (18 months) oak aged beers, creating an amazing, refreshing drink combining the flavours of red fruits and chocolate, with a dry acidic finish.

A blend of one third young and two thirds two year oak aged beers, this is without doubt the classic Flemish Red. Amazingly sour, while remaining ridiculously refreshing.

## Dark

De Dolle Brouwers                      33cl                                      9.0%                                      £11.90  
Oerbier

The original beer from the mad brothers. This beer is amazingly complex and as smooth as silk. It is full of sweet fruits, port flavours and liquorice, combined with vinous tartness, and a dry hoppiness lurking in the background. One to savour.

A velvety smooth beer that hides its strength well. There are hints of sweet fruits alongside a slight tartness, but the dominant flavour is cocoa. Ridiculously easy drinking for such a strong dark beer.

The 'golden dragon' is a powerful beast! Don't be fooled by its majestic beauty - behind the rich, full flavoured, elegant taste, there is a potent brew. There are definite rum and raisin notes in the aroma and taste, with hints of herbs and spices. Having only one of these is a real test of will power.

This magnificent heavy Abbey beer just begs to finish off a cold winter night. A spell-binding mixture of sweet fruits dominate the flavours, with the gentlest of hints of tartness in the background. A blissful indulgence that will warm your soul.

St. Bernardus Abt. 12                      33cl                                      10.0%                                      £8.50

A powerful beer, with plums, raisins and figs soaked in dark spiced rum absolutely dominating the palate. However, the delectable port flavours and subtle spicy hops soon come to caress you, with a gentle, comforting, velvet embrace.

Fruit, Wheat, and Lambic

Bacchus Framboise 37.5cl 5.0% £9.60

A deep, dark ruby red raspberry beer, with a beautiful sweet yet tart fruit pie flavour and a refreshing, spritzy finish.

Blanche de Bruxelles 33cl 4.5% £5.60

This is a great example of a cloudy, unfiltered wheat beer. It has a lovely, floral aroma and a beautifully balanced mix of clove, lemongrass, orange and lemon zest flavours.

A smooth and relatively strong Gueuze beer, with well balanced dry and tart flavours of sour green apples and gooseberries. Reminiscent of a cocktail made with dry cider and very dry champagne.

Fairly sweet, dark red beer with a strong cherry flavour.

Liefmans Cuvee Brut Kriek	33cl	6.0%	£7.20

Not to be confused with a lambic Kriek, this brown ale is aged with whole cherries for a year, and then blended with old brown and Goudenband beer of different ages. A very complex, well balanced, medium sweet beer with a fantastic rich cherry flavour.

A fruity beauty! This is a full on sweet fruit lambic. It has a big peach aroma, a bigger peach flavour, and just a hint of lambic sourness, with the dry fruit, skin and stone taste lingering in the background. It's just peachy!
