Champagne & Sparkling

Gocce di Favola Prosecco Extra Dry Veneto NV (Italy) 20cl £9.50 75cl £27.00

Our "House Fizz" available in single serve 20cl or full bottle 75cl to share, Favola is a fresh, fragrant and fruity Prosecco with aromas of pear and apple. **11% ABV**

Pinord, Cava "+ & - Seleccion" Bruit NV (Spain) 75cl £32.50

A fresh, light and enjoyable Cava from Catalonia, with refreshing citrus notes leading to a delightful & elegant finish **11.5% ABV**

Champagne Marc Hébrart, Cuvée de Réserve Brut NV (France) 75cl £70.50

This family owned Champagne house comprising 15.5 hectares of vines averaging 30 years of age produces a delicious Champagne with a mature biscuity nose, complex flavour with hints of red apple and an impressively long finish. **12.5% ABV**



White Wines

Chéreau Carré, Muscadet Sèvre et Maine 2018 (France) 175ml £5.00 250ml £9.00 75cl £25.00

This classic Muscadet from the Loire Valley is refreshing and pure, with white fruit and citrus characters combined with a crisp acidity, bright minerality and a lemony hint on the finish. **12% ABV**

Gérard Bertrand "Gème Sens Blanc", Pays d'oc 2018 (France) 175ml £5.50 250ml £9.50 75cl £25.50

Gérard Bertrand is one of the most outstanding winemakers in the South of France, where he owns numerous estates among the most prestigious crus of Languedoc - Roussillon. With wonderfully complex floral nose showing notes of laurel and acacia and an underlying fruitiness from tropical and citrus fruits, Gème Sens is equally aromatic on the palate, supported by a pleasing fresh crispness and a lovely suave, smooth finish. **12% ABV**

Tournée du Sud, Picpoul de Pinet 2019 (France) 75cl £29.00

A poised dry white wine, showing a creamy character of apricot and green apple and just a hint of cinnamon. A perfect accompaniment to fish. **13% ABV**

Pazo de Mar "Coral do Mar" Rías Baixas, Albariño 2019 (Spain) 75cl £35.00

This estate grown and bottled Albariño shows stone fruit characters with delicate spicy notes on the nose, which are echoed on the palate along with citrus characters. This poised wine is all held together by a crisp backbone of refreshing and zesty acidity. **13% ABV**

Saint Clair "Tuatara Bay", Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2019 (New Zealand) 75cl £36.00

Sunshine in a glass! From pioneer Marlborough winemakers Neal & Judy Ibbotson's Saint Clair Family Estate, Tuatara bay is a dry, crisp wine with herbaceous flavours of pea pods through to a zesty and fresh finish. A fabulous example of Kiwi Sauvignon blanc and tremendous value for money. **13% ABV**

Chateau Lestrille Capmartin, bordeaux blanc 2018 (France) 75cl £42.00

Beautiful rich and creamy wine showing beeswax and hoined ginger flavours through to a lovely, long finish, classy, elegant and full of flavour. **13.5% ABV**

Red Wines

Tierra Antica, Valle Central, Merlot 2019 (Chile) 175ml £5.00 250ml £9.00 75cl £25.00

Red and black fruit aromas of juicy cherries and plums with a touch of chocolate, quaffable Merlot style. **13% ABV**

Domaine des Pourthié Pays d'Oc, Cabernet Sauvignon 2018 (France) 175ml £5.50 250ml £9.50 75cl £27.00

A deeply coloured Cabernet Sauvignon with Pronounced aromas of blackcurrant, black cherries and subtle notes of coffee. Smooth and velvety, the tannins are beautifully integrated and envelop the spicy fruit through to a deliciously smoky finish. **13.5% ABV**

Doña Paula "Paula", Lujan de Cuyo, Malbec 2019 (Argentina) 75cl £29.00

An accessible and rounded Malbec, with notes of red cherry through to a spicy finish; a perfect Sunday Roast red! **13.5% ABV**

Château Saint-Romans Bordeaux 2017 (France) 75cl £32.00

A good quality drinking Claret, with an attractive nose of red berries and black fruits complemented by subtle toasted notes. Supple and silky on the palate with mellow tannins and a smooth finish. **13.5% ABV**

Bodegas Ondarre, "Rivallana", Crianza, Rioja 2017 (Spain) 75cl £34.00

Savoury and mellow flavours complemented by vanilla notes from oak ageing; Traditional Rioja style. **13.5% ABV**

Gérard Bertrand "Terrior" Saint Chinian 2017 (France) 75cl £42.00

A lovely wine from the South of France showing delicious olive and liquorice flavours with vanilla notes - spicy and intensely flavoured. **14% ABV**



Rosé Wines

Les Boules Rosé, Pays d'Oc 2018 (France) 175ml £5.00 250ml £9.00 75cl £25.00

This pale salmon pink rosé shows fruity aromas of grenadine and vibrant red fruits followed by a round and fresh finish. **14% ABV**

Château de l'Aumérade "Cuvée Marie Christine" Cru Classé Côtes de Provence Rosé 2019 (France) 75cl £35.00

Elegantly styled, with aromas of pink grapefruit, fresh red berries with a hint of vanilla culminating in a refreshing finish - provençal rosé at its best **12.5% ABV**
