

Winter Wines Sale!



Sparkling wines...

Veneto, Italy, Nua, Prosecco Spumante, (ve) 75cl... £25.95 Crisp and refreshing, fully-sparkling Prosecco; succulent citrus and tropical fruits.

Veneto, Italy, Nua, Rosé Spumante, (ve) 75cl... £25.95 Lightly aromatic with notes of melon, pear and sweet cranberry

Veneto, Italy (ve) – Prosecco/ Prosecco Rosé, 20cl... £7.75

England, Lyme Bay, Devon, sparkling 75cl... was £59.95, now £50, Hints of rose petals and a soft strawberry character, this crisp, medium bodied sparkling wine also has a citrus character and fine, persistent bubbles.

Champagne, France, **De Castellane, Champagne Brut**, 75cl... was £59.95, now £50, Vibrant and characterful Champagne; fresh and clean with hints of toast and brioche

White wine by the glass...

House White: South Africa - Flagstone Noon Gun, Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon & Viognier... £18.95 (250ml £6.65 175ml £5.65, 125ml £4.35) A

Vibrant and aromatic showing ripe, fleshy, freshly cut stone fruits. Bright acidity delivers delicious balance.

- Italy Fantinel Borgo Tesis, Pinot Grigio, Grave del Friuli DOC (ve)... £25.95 (250ml £8.75 175ml £7.20, 125ml £4.50) A stylish Pinot, laden with orchard fruit, fresh orange and lime. Soft and easy drinking.
- New Zealand Vidal Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough... £25.95 (250ml £8.75 175ml £7.20, 125ml £4.50) Classic gooseberry and passion fruit aromas mingled with a crisp, citrus flavour.
- New Zealand Waimea Estates Gewürztraminer, Nelson ...£26.95 (250ml £8.95 175ml £7.45, 125ml £4.95) An intense, tropical-fruit-laden wine, orange zest and lychee, embellished with floral notes, off-dry.

Winter Wine Sale... White wine by the bottle...

Australia – The Courtesan Riesling, Clare Valley (ve)... was £27.95, now £25, Lime citrus with notes of elderflower, grapefruit, ripe melon and hints of quince. And it leaves with a very clean and dry finish.

Australia – **Red Knot Chardonnay, Yarra Valley...** was £34.95, now £30 Lemon rind, mandarin, cashew nuts and honeydew melon aromas. A medium-bodied wine with flavours of peach and lime, a deliciously textured palate and a long, fresh, zesty finish. A small portion of Sémillon was included in the blend for added complexity and structure. (ve)

Spain - Pulpo Albariño, Rías Baixas... was £34.95, now £30 Aromas of white flowers, hints of peach and apricot lead to a fresh, fruity palate; it has a lovely intensity and an almost saline minerality (ve)

France - Chablis Cellier de la Sablière, Louis Jadot... was £49.95, now £40 Louis Jadot's winemaker deliberately produces a fuller style of Chablis, more akin to some wines from the Côte d'Or. The wine is allowed to undergo a partial malolactic fermentation to soften and round the palate. (v)

New Zealand – Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough... was £54.95, mow £45 Uber-premium Marlborough sauvignon, for those that adore the grape and the region. In the 80's the Cloudy Bay brand pioneered and revolutionised New Zealand's international gravitas for wine making and still produces some of the best value sauvignon blanc in the world. Layers of guava, gooseberry, tropical fruits and a dusting of fresh herbs.



Red wine by the glass...

House Red: Italy - Salice Salentino Riserva, Marchese di Borgosole, Puglia... £22.95 (250ml £7.85, 175ml £5.95, 125ml £4.35) Dried red and black fruits, chocolate, coffee, figs, prune, leather, tobacco, hazelnut. This wine is complex and delicious.

Australia – Soldier's Block, Malbec... £25.95 (250ml £8.75 175ml £7.20, 125ml £4.50) Hints of plum, black berries and a touch of vanilla. (ve)

New Zealand – Neptune point, Pinot Noir, Marlborough...£26.95 (250ml £8.95 175ml £7.45, 125ml £4.95) Violets, plum, raspberry and black cherry. Often enjoyed by those preferring less full-bodied red wines.

Winter Wine Sale... Red wine by the bottle...

USA - Burlesque old vine Zinfandel, Lodi... was £27.95, now £25 A full bodied zinfandel, the Burlesque 'Old Vine' Zinfandel is packed with damson fruit flavours with a twist of black pepper.

Spain - Marqués de Morano Rioja Reserva... was £34.95, now £30 Full bodied and muscular, yet smoothly polished and embellished with complex aromas of vanilla and toasted oak, combined with summer fruit flavours.

Australia- **Red Knot Shiraz, Yarra Valley...** was £34.95, now £30 A vibrant, medium to full-bodied shiraz with primary fruit flavours of ripe strawberry and blackberry, enhanced by nuances of peppery black spice and subtly framed with American and French oak. (ve)

Italy - Chianti Antica Cinta Fiasco, Tenute Piccini... was £34.95, now £30 Served in a 'Fiasco'- a typical Italian round bottle, partially covered with a close-fitting straw basket for a lovely, theatrical serve. A smooth wine with soft tannins and distinct notes of red fruit. (ve)

France - Château La Fleur Plaisance, Montagne-Saint-Émilion... was £49.95, now £40 Classic 'right-bank' Bordeaux. A soft wine with a delicious red-fruit character, aged in oak and in bottle.

South Africa - **The Chocolate Block, Boekenhoutskloof, Swartland**... was £49.95, now £40 Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault, Cabernet Sauvignon with a touch of Viognier for added perfume. It's seriously plush. Full bodied with a chocolate note, dark berry fruit, plums, blackberries, blueberries and black pepper.

Italy – La Zoccolaio 2015 Barolo... was £59.95, now £50 Undoubtedly one of the greatest full-bodied wine styles in the world, a real treat for any wine lover. Powerful, sweet aroma of violets and black cherries has with a velvety texture, red fruit notes and light nuances of liquorice. God's own tipple.

Italy – La Colombaia Amarone della valpolicella 2018 was £59.95, now £50 Ripe, warm and generous on the nose with plum and cherry aromas and hints of dried fruits. Full bodied and richly flavoured with rich berry and plum fruit, supple tannins and a spicy finish, with the characteristic dry bite of good Amarone.

France - Aime Arnoux Chateauneuf du Pape 2020... was £59.95, now £50 An expert blend of old-vine Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Terret Noir. It boasts elegant notes of red fruit and black pepper and herbaceous aromas.

New Zealand - Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir, Marlborough... was £69.95, now £60 Rose petals, dark cherries and blackberries fill the nose. On the palate, a core of rounded bramble fruit, ripe boysenberry and wild strawberry is unpinned by silky tannins and fine acidity. A concentrated yet elegant wine.



Rosé and orange wines...

USA – Out of America Zinfandel, California... £18.95 (250ml £6.65 175ml £5.65, 125ml £4.35) Medium-sweet pink with sweet raspberry, watermelon, and strawberry fruit

Italy - **Pinot Grigio 'Blush' Rosé, La Voluta grande, delle Venezie**... £25.95 (250ml £8.75 175ml £7.20, 125ml £4.50) Soft, coppery-pink colour; delicate and fruity bouquet; soft and fresh on the palate

Austria - Winzer Krems 'Orange' Gruner Veltliner... was £25.95, now £25 You've heard of red, white and rose wines, well, welcome to 'orange' wine. Left to macerate for 18 days to develop to a deeper colour and a rich fuller texture, with flavours of quince, peach and spice. (ve)

Dessert Wine...

France - Dulong Prestige Sauternes 50c1... £26.95 (100ml £5.95) A subtle combination of citrus, fruits, spices, white flowers and honey.

Hungary - St. Tamas 'Mad' Late Harvest Tokaji 37.5cl... £35.95 (100ml £9.95) Floral, fruity intense aromas, a touch of minerality and a fresh fruity lingering finish.
