

Wine at the Windmill

By the glass... or by the bottle

We don't have a 'house wine' as such, but have nine wines that we offer by the glass as well as by the bottle. They've been carefully selected to provide a fine experience even if you've only got time for a small glass.

Red Wines

Finca De Oro Rioja - Spain 12.5%

A Tempranillo Rioja that's a surprisingly refined and complex mid-bodied red wine, showing dark fruit, spice and oak aromas.

Drop Dead Gorgeous Malbec - South Africa 13.5%

An excellent - and very popular - South African mid bodied red with jammy dark plummy fruit and ripe tannins.

Aimery Merlot - France 12.5%

The soft, fruity character of the Merlot grape makes this dark red wine agreeably easy to drink, with aromas of red fruit, black currant, and a hint of cocoa, and minerals in the nose.

Grapeful Dead Shiraz - Australia 14%

Australia's most popular grape varietal, Shiraz, in an off-dry, mid bodied fruity red, with vibrant berry and plum on both the nose and palate, that is soft in acidity and tannin.

White Wines

Aimery Sauvignon Blanc - France 12.5%

A grassy dry white wine from the home of the Sauvignon grape. Citrus and mineral notes with a hint of green nettle, good acidity and a crisp finish.

Lyrice Pinot Grigio - Italy 12%

A really characterful Pinot Grigio, with tempting apricot, peach and melon fruit notes.

Grapeful Dead Chardonnay - Australia 13.5%

A dry and lively Chardonnay with some pear and spice aromas.

Rosé Wines

O&E Zinfandel Rosé - USA 10.5%

Light-bodied and sweet, full of summer berry fruit flavours.

Aimery Cabernet Rosé - France 12.5%

An excellent Cabernet Rosé from the South of France (made from the Cabernet Franc grape variety) displays everything that you would be looking for in a classic dry French Rosé: fresh and crisp with pleasant strawberry, summer fruit and rose petal aromas.

Red Wine

Dead Man's Dice Malbec - Argentina 13%

This very popular young Argentinian wine is deep and vibrant, with an intense nose of plum, damson and dark chocolate aromas.

Domaine Mas Belles Eaux Petit Verdot - France 14.5%

An impressive Deep and inky red from the deep South of France from the Petit Verdot grape. The wine has an intense purple hue and combines youthful dark violet and blueberry aromas with a mid to full-bodied palate.

Mâcon Rouge Vignerons des Terres Secrètes - France 12.5%

A Southern Burgundy red. A really happy red wine with youthful dark fruit exhaling strong notes of blackcurrant and blackberry, with a touch of spice on the nose and a mid to light-bodied palate.

Las Ondas Pinot Noir Reserva - Chili 13%

From the Central Valley vineyards of Chilli, this makes the best of the wonderful Pinot Noir grape. Soft and not too heavy in the mouth with scrumptious red berry and spice aromas.

Le Terre Del Barolo - Italy 15%

The “King of wines” from Piemonte, Northern Italy, Italy. Made from the Nebbiolo grape. This brick red wine has a complex, woody nose, with a lingering flavour of liquorice on the palate.

150+1 Piemonte Langhe DOC Barbera - Italy 13.5%

Award winning, delicious. Lots of black cherry fruit, overlaid with vanilla oak, enliven this mid-bodied red.

Fortin Plaisance St Emilion - France 15%

A windmill favourite, from Libournais, Bordeaux. Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. A splendid, deep ruby red. Notes of old leather, quince, black cherry and toast on the nose. A silky initial taste blossoms on the palate into a full bodied wine with beautiful balance between dark fruit and oak. A warm, aromatic finish leaves the palate with pleasant, toasted flavours.

Domaine De Panisse, Châteauneuf-du-Pape - France 14%

The star of any wine list. A fabulous, big rich wine from the Southern Rhône Valley, made from Shiraz/Syrah, Grenache, Mourvedre grapes. Shows wonderful aromatic complexity: warm and spicy aromas with flavours of red fruit, rose petals and herbs.

Croze Hermitage Pradelle - France 15%

Made with the Shiraz grape in the Rhône region, this is an excellent deep, rich, concentrated wine. It has rich flavours of pepper, eucalyptus and dark berries.



White Wine

Albariño Laxas - Spain 12.5%

A Windmill favourite! An excellent example of this delicious - and fashionable - dry white wine from Rías Baixas in Galicia, Northern Spain. Clean and bright wine, straw yellow with greenish flashes. On the nose it presents an intense aroma, perfectly blending fruity and floral notes, highlighting apple and apricot. On the palate, the typical freshness of Albariño stands out, with a very tight acidity perfectly balanced with the structure and body of the wine.

Beneventano Falanghina Vesevo - Italy 13%

A broad, well textured dry white wine from the Campania region using the Falanghina grape. Elegant with a delicate but attractive fruit character. Perfumes of white flowers and white melon with mineral notes provide a backdrop to the full, ripe palate. Just a hint of honey on the finish.

Vinho Verde Adegas de Monção - Portugal 13%

Young, fruity character, delightfully crisp and juicy with notes of peach, lime and green apple, Alvarinho and Trajadura Bright appearance. Citrus colour. Fruity, dry and delicious.

Mâcon-Lugny Les Petites Pierres, Louis Jadot - France 13%

From the Côte Mâconnaise, a nice illustration of the best of this region of Burgundy, made from the Chardonnay grape. Delightful floral, fruity aroma and fresh lemony palate. This wine is vegan friendly.

Picpoul de Pinet Cuvee Thetis - France 12.5%

A new addition from the Coteaux du Languedoc, a dry and light-bodied white wine that has a good balance of fruit and freshness.

Chablis Moreau - France 13%

Award-winning Chablis. Fabulously steely and dry, with a hint of green in the colour. Like all fine Chablis, the fruit is balanced by crisp acidity.

Sparkling Wine



Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial - France 12%

This Champagne, made with Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier grapes, is distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity. It has a slight appley, yeasty nose and long, rich flavours of biscuity, toasty fruit.

Ponte Prosecco - Italy 12% (20cl)

Our small bottle of Prosecco, made with the Glera grape. Clean, dry and crisp, with a creamy finish.

Zimor Prosecco - Italy 11%

Intensely sparkling with light, fresh, appley aromas. Not too dry on the palate, pale greenish lemon appearance. Just the right amount of balancing acidity. Gentle finish.

Aimery Crémant De Limoux Brut - France 12%

Travel to Limoux in the South in France and here you will find an often over-looked, but long-established sparkling wine called Crémant de Limoux. If you really like Champagne but are on a budget, then this is the wine for you. It is produced in the same way as Champagne with the second fermentation (which produces the fizz) carried out in the bottle, as opposed to in a pressurised steel tank as is the case with the vast majority of Prosecco production. Following this process, the wine is aged for 18 months on its lees (i.e. the yeast sediment left over after the second fermentation) which gives the wine its toasty/ bready character, similar to Champagne. Aimery Crémant de Limoux Brut NV is produced by the Sieur d'Arques winery and is made from a blend of Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc and Pinot Noir. It has plenty of fresh ripe fruit flavours (apple and peach) and an elegant creamy, toasty finish.

Aimery Crémant De Limoux Rose - France 12.5%

In addition to their excellent sparkling white Crémant, Sieurs d'Arques also produce this delicious Rosé version made from the same grape varieties: Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc and Pinot Noir). Displaying plenty of strawberry flavours and a creamy, mouth filling finish, this Rosé fizz is an absolutely perfect substitute for pink Champagne!
