Public Toilets

PEOPLE EXPOSED

- Colleagues
- Visitors/Guest
- Contractors
- Members of the public

HAZARDS

- Assisting the spread of COVID -19 for staff and the public If controls are not considered then we may increase the risk of COVID-19 spreading from the site. Toilets will be difficult to manage but with some simple controls in place the risk can be lowered to a reasonable level

CONTROL MEASURES

- The toilet area will be inspected every 30 minutes and all touch surfaces like door handles, locks, taps, will be sanitised and a checklist will be displayed in the toilets.
- Propping access doors open to minimise contact points. Consider people's privacy is not affected by doing this
- We will maintain a 1m/2m distancing by blocking off the middle urinal as well as the middle sink in the gent's toilets
- We will close the middle ladies' toilet and middle sink.
- Signs will be displayed on door that only two people may enter toilets at any one time.

- Hand sanitiser will be available at entry to the toilet points as well as hand sanitiser and soap and hot water at sinks.
- Signs will be displayed reminding people to wash their hands
- Allowing good ventilation by keeping windows open where possible and propping open doors.
